Topic Proposals for BSACI Standards of Care Committee

The BSACI Standards of Care Committee (SOCC) oversees the Society's output of documents including Guidelines, Clinical Practice Statements, and other Clinical Guidance, Standard Operating Procedures and Management Plans. SOCC develops <u>guidelines</u> for use in primary and secondary care by both adult and paediatric allergists/immunologists and allied health professionals. SOCC leads on national allergy <u>audits</u>.

The SOCC will consider the following factors in the approval process for a new guideline or non-guideline document- please address these points in **the topic proposal form below**.

- Are there areas of clinical uncertainty as evidenced by wide variation in practice or outcomes?
- Is this a condition where effective treatment is proven and where mortality or morbidity can be reduced?
- Is this a clinical priority area for BSACI where clinical guidance is lacking (and with a perceived need for guidance) and the area is unlikely to be produced by other organisations (such as NICE or EAACI or patient organisations)?

Each proposal should have the support of a BSACI Specialist Interest Group/Committee (SIG/C), if a relevant group exists.
